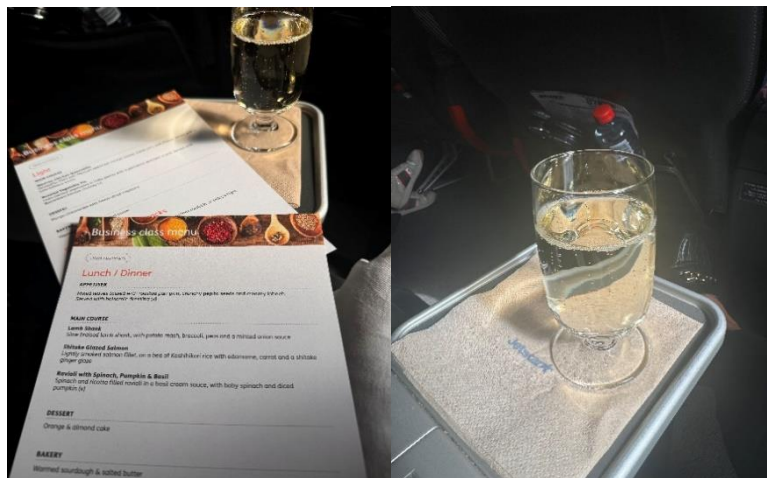


## Bundle of the Month – BUSINESS MAX

## Lounge Access

Tying into our Bundle of the Month – the Business Max – below is some valuable information for your clients so they can access the lounges on the network.

Lounge access<sup>1</sup> is available for your Business Max passengers departing on international flights with a JQ, 3K or QF code receive access to partner lounges and Qantas Club lounge, where available. Access is available from when their check-in desk opens until when their flight starts boarding. Lounge access is not available on arrival at their destination, or when they have a connecting flight for which they have not purchased a Business Class fare with Max bundle<sup>2</sup>. Access to the following lounges is available for Business Max passengers:

AIRPORT	LOUNGE NAME AND LOCATION
Gold Coast Airport, Australia	Gold Coast Qantas Club directly – after domestic and international security screening
Melbourne International Airport, Australia	Qantas Melbourne International Business Lounge – Airside, Level 1, enter via departures concourse
Sydney International Airport, Australia	Sydney International Business Lounge – Airside, Level 3, enter via escalators
Denpasar International Airport, Bali, Indonesia	Premier Lounge – Take the lift from Level 3 to Mezzanine Level
Singapore Changi International Airport, Singapore	Qantas Singapore International Lounge – Airside, Terminal 1, turn left after Immigration, up escalators. Blossom Lounge – Level 2 Mezzanine, Departure/Transit Lounge, Terminal 4 <b>Important:</b> From 22 March 2023, Jetstar will operate from Terminal 4. Remember to allow sufficient time to arrive at the boarding gate.
Bangkok Suvarnabhumi International Airport, Thailand	<b>New from 1<sup>st</sup> October 2024: AF/KLM Lounge</b>
Phuket International Airport, Thailand	The Coral Executive Lounge – 4th floor, international departures
Honolulu International Airport, Hawaii	Qantas International Business Lounge Lower Level, follow signs to Airline Lounges/Cultural Garden
Incheon International Airport, Seoul, South Korea	Oneworld lounge - Located in Terminal 1, near gate 28

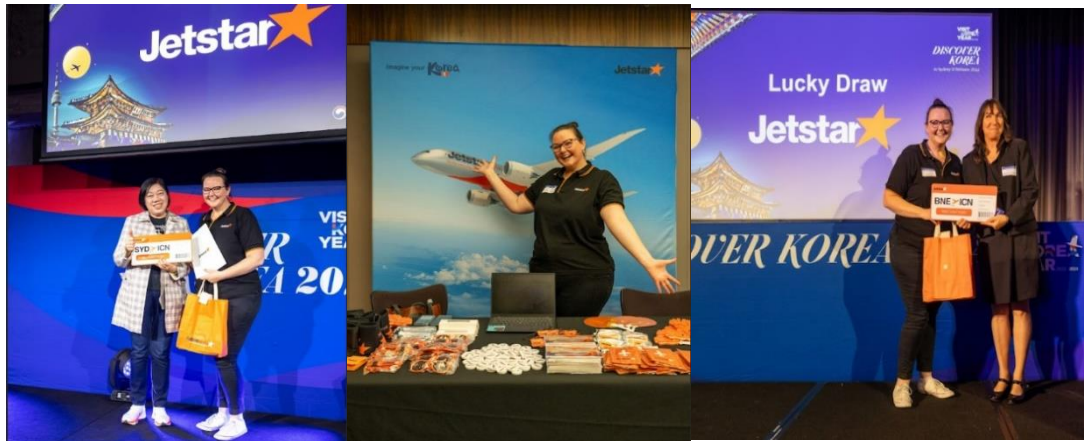
