Getting lucky

It's that time of the year when people start handing out lucky packets for Chinese New Year – envelopes coloured red to symbolise good luck. The envelopes contain cash, and are usually given by married people to single friends or work colleagues, or fed into the mouths of lion dancers during New Year celebrations. If you're wondering how much money to put in an envelope, go for any even-numbered denomination (except numbers containing a four, as that is bad luck due to the symbol for four closely resembling the symbol for death). If you are handing out lots of packets, \$8 in each is a safe bet, as eight is a lucky number due to its pronunciation being similar to "fa", meaning wealth, or fortune.

Singapore: lights and parades

Until 28 February

The Lunar New Year is one of Singapore's biggest events. More than just a parade, the festivities run for over two weeks, until 28 February.

WHERE TO GO: Chinatown is the focal point of the celebrations, with night markets, light installations and street performers. Highlights of the festivities are the Chingay Parade on 27–28 February, and the River Hongbao, a festival of street entertainment, fireworks and games, both hosted near the marina waterfront.

Hong Kong: tradition and family

19–21 February

The celebrations in this city are lively and full of hope for the year ahead. Try to sample Chinese delicacies, eaten at the Lunar New Year to set up the year to come: black moss for prosperity, dried oysters for good business, and *tangyuan* (sweet rice

balls) for reunion with friends and family. Locals also visit temples to give thanks and pray for good fortune.

WHERE TO GO: The highlight of the festival is the Night Parade on 19 February, which features performers traversing the harbour-front area to usher in a prosperous and lucky new year. Also see the Victoria Harbour fireworks display on the 20th, and the Spring Festival Races at Sha Tin Racecourse on the 21st.

Sydney: food and festivities

13 February – 1 March

The period is packed with events,

from parades and lion dances to food specials and light installations, in the streets, in restaurants and even on the harbour.

WHERE TO GO: Check out discounted set-menu deals at a range of Asian restaurants (including Ms G's, Spice Temple and Din Tai Fung), and stroll around the Lanterns of the Terracotta Warriors light artwork by Chinese artist Xia Nan at Dawes Point. The Twilight Parade is on 22 February starting at Town Hall, and the Dragon Boat Races are a spectacle at Cockle Bay from 28 February to 1 March.

Going underground

The State Library of Victoria explores why Melbourne has long been home to the counterculture

"I AM A BOHEMIAN. I live, I walk, I eat, drink and philosophise," wrote Australia's first well-known bohemian, Marcus Clarke, who went on to find fame after publishing his book *For the Term of his Natural Life*. He came to live in Australia as a 16-year-old in 1863, when avant-garde arts, literature, theatre and a thriving café and bar scene were filtering down from Europe to the Antipodes.

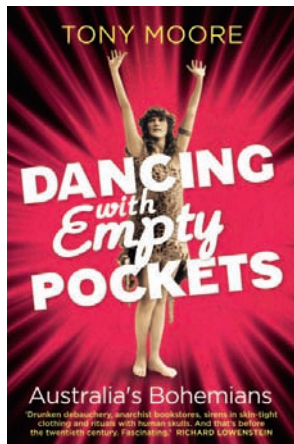
It's fitting that one of the first things you see as you enter the *Bohemian Melbourne* exhibition at the State Library of Victoria is a portrait of Clarke alongside the first

published book on bohemia – Parisian journalist Henri Murger's *Scènes de la vie de bohème*, published in 1851, which describes the life of a group of artists, musicians, actors and writers who lived their lives in coffee shops, bars and theatres, and coveted a life free of responsibility and full of creativity and spontaneity.

Hundreds of photos, artworks, film, video, interviews and music celebrate the lives of some of Melbourne's most eccentric and influential creatives over the past 150 years. They include painters of the Heidelberg School, theatrical ragamuffins such as Graeme Blundell and prankster Barry Humphries (in early adulthood, well before the Daming of Edna), through to a young Nick Cave.

One local bohemian being introduced to a wider audience via the exhibition is artist Vali Myers, who left Australia at a young age after having been a lead dancer at the Melbourne Modern Ballet Company. She ended up working as a dancer in Paris cafés and nightclubs and it was there that she started drawing her incredibly detailed, colourful fantasies. These are on show alongside illustrated diaries and some of her over-the-top, though gorgeous, jewellery.

It's sad to think some of the bohemians in the exhibition are no longer with us, because moving through 15 generations of these lives makes you realise how much fun they would have been to know. ➤➤



Follow in the footsteps of Melbourne's original bohos

The last night of the exhibition, 21 Feb, corresponds to the citywide, all-night art event White Night, with the exhibition open from 7pm until 7am the following morning.

The actor of Arrernte/Arabana Australian Aboriginal descent from Alice Springs tells us about the importance of Indigenous film

HOW DID YOU GET INTO ACTING?

I was a journalist first. Then I applied to do some acting when I was about 25 and fell into it through storytelling. I've always had a consciousness that there haven't been a lot of Indigenous people on TV for a long time.

WHAT DO YOU LIKE MOST ABOUT IT?

I get an opportunity to share my culture and my stories with people who otherwise wouldn't get a chance to experience them. I get a chance to inform and empower them through the arts. For me that's paramount to how we grow as a nation.

WHAT BALANCE SHOULD THERE BE BETWEEN INDIGENOUS STORIES AND INDIGENOUS PEOPLE IN MAINSTREAM FILMS?

For me it's about getting us on mainstream Australian TV and being acknowledged. With projects like *City Homicide*, people who haven't

had any contact with Indigenous Australians get a chance to have some contact... That personalises it a bit. People become more familiar. It's so important that we remain visual and you see us in all walks of life.

WHAT IS BLAK NITE SCREEN?

It's an opportunity to have contact with Indigenous Australians but also to enjoy the relaxing nature of who we are as people. We're going to focus on David Gulpilil, a national treasure; we've got performers Frank Yamma and Ursula Yovich – great musicians. We've got also Indigenous feature films and television series. For us it's a beautiful platform to tell

stories... We want everyone to come down and enjoy black film and Indigenous storytelling. ★

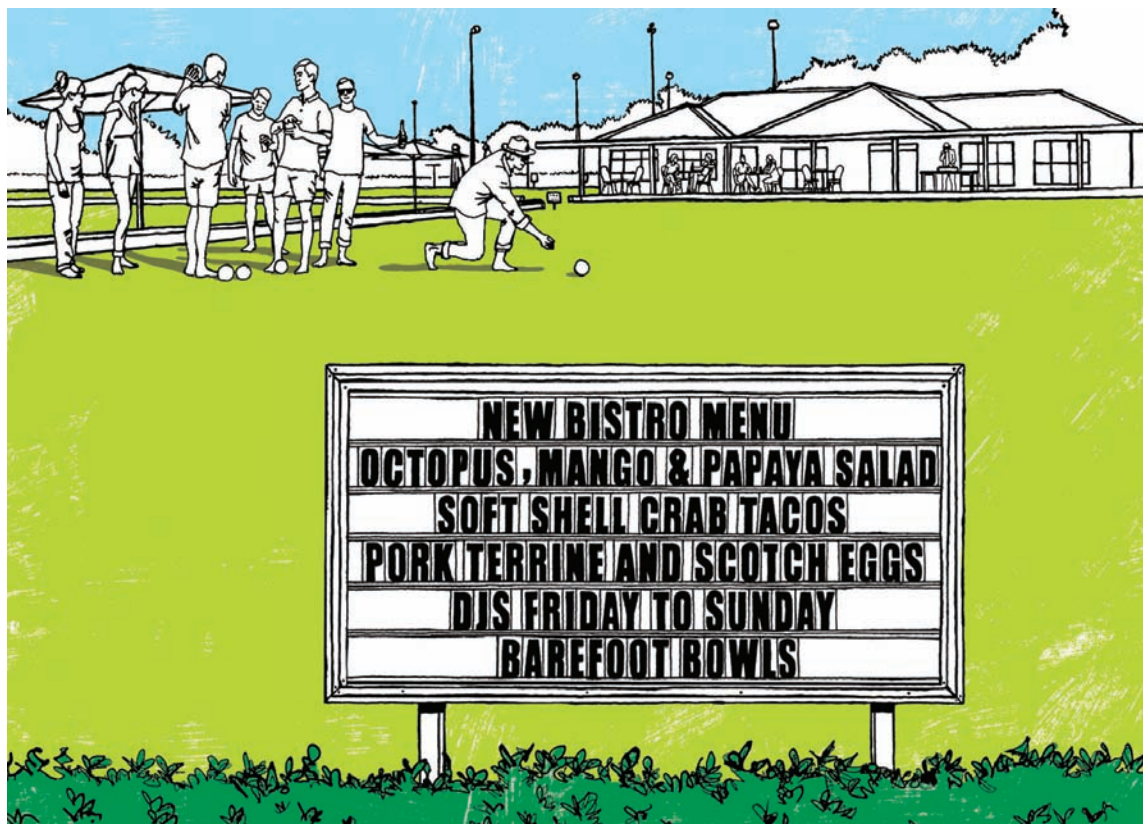

Eat, drink, bowl

We visit three refurbished lawn-bowls clubs that are scoring high points on the food front

IT'S NO SECRET AUSSIE BOWLING clubs have been battling dwindling membership and rising land taxes, with some even facing closure. But thanks to the introduction of barefoot and twilight games, music pros taking over the entertainment, and refurbishments of the clubhouses, including kitchens and bars, they're scoring a new legion of fans a long way off from retirement.

In late 2013, the bowls scene was, well, bowled over when ex-Vue de Monde chef Clinton McIver popped up in a French-inspired fine diner,

Champions Bistro, at Melbourne's Bowls Clayton. While his innings there is now over, the bowls community paid attention, and clubs all over the country are now trying to coax people through the gates with better food options than Smith's crisps and Nobby's nuts.

"We've seen a jump in the number of social members by a couple of hundred already," says Bondi Bowling Club president John Wright, regarding his club's reopening last November.

The makeover of the 1930s brick building remains faithful to its club-

like feel, but the food and beverage menu has been turned on its head. Anthony Kaplan, co-owner of Bondi hotspots The Corner House and Panama Bar, has locals rolling in for \$5.00 bar snacks and affordable mains. Menu highlights include the ploughman's platter and a salad of barbecued octopus, mango and papaya with a lime-and-palm-sugar dressing.

"The club's also invested substantially to turn this space into a live music venue," says Troy Barrott, who oversees its entertainment. "We

have a great schedule of DJs from Friday to Sunday, live music on public holidays, film screenings, fitness classes and kids' activities."

From Friday afternoons to Sunday evenings families and young punters also head to the North Fremantle Bowling Club for barefoot bowls.

With no budget for a bistro, the club wheels one in on Sundays. Caterers Ben Foss and Ben French from Eat No Evil serve organic Mexican fare from their food van. Around mid-afternoon the tangy scents of pork belly with pineapple, coriander and wasabi mayo inside steamed bao buns, and of soft-shell-crab tacos with watermelon, feta and mint, waft out from its counter.

"There's normally a DJ spinning records, and the lawn is covered in picnic blankets and cushions with shade covers above," says manager Emma Rush. "It's a chilled atmosphere."

For jaw-dropping views of Sydney Harbour, head to The Greens, perched atop prime hillside real estate on the Lower North Shore. Husband-and-wife team Lilly and Nathan Fasan have re-booted the 125-year-old Norths Bowlo with an innovative menu.

"The food is unpretentious and wholesome with a focus on produce and sharing a meal with family and friends," says Lilly.

Grazing on the green-and-red-tomato salad on a zesty watermelon gazpacho base with black olives and whipped goats feta, and the platter of pork terrine with cured meats, house pickles, brie and Scotch eggs in the courtyard area overlooking the water, is reason enough to forfeit a game. ★

Barbecue battle!

Each year, St Kilda hosts the BBQ Throwdown, where a chef from the Newmarket Hotel takes on one of the Melbourne's best barbecue chefs. This month, Daniel Hawkins takes on Kong BBQ's Benjamin Cooper. Their challenge? Brisket!

Round 1: Benjamin Cooper, Kong BBQ

FRIED RICE, KIMCHI AND BRISKET
BURNT ENDS WITH FRIED EGG



INGREDIENTS

- 1 cup cooked Japanese rice (day old works best)
- 1/3 cup kimchi and its juice
- 1/2 cup burnt brisket ends, roughly chopped
- 1 tbsp peas
- 1 handful chopped Chinese broccoli
- 2 tbsp caster sugar
- 2 free-range eggs
- 3 tbsp oyster sauce
- 1 tbsp gochujang (Korean hot pepper paste)
- 1 tbsp light soy sauce
- 2 tbsp sesame oil
- 1 tsp shichimi togarashi (Japanese Seven Spice)

METHOD

- 1 Heat the oil in a wok and scramble one of the eggs; meanwhile, pan-fry the other egg.
- 2 Add brisket ends to the wok, along with kimchi and rice. Stir-fry for a couple of minutes until the rice is broken into individual grains.
- 3 Season with sugar, oyster sauce, gochujang and soy sauce.
- 4 Add the peas and Chinese broccoli and toss until heated through.
- 5 Check seasoning and balance, then transfer into a bowl and top with the fried egg.
- 6 To garnish, sprinkle with shichimi togarashi.

Round 2: Daniel Hawkins, Newmarket Hotel

PIT BARBACOA BRISKET WITH HOT VINEGAR SAUCE

INGREDIENTS

Meat:

- 1 piece of good-quality beef brisket
- Hickory wood smoking chips, soaked in water for 30 min
- Meat stock

Spice rub:

- Black pepper, ground
- Fennel seeds, toasted and ground
- Cumin seeds, toasted and ground
- Smoked paprika
- Salt

Hot vinegar sauce:

- 1 red capsicum, diced
- 1 red onion, diced
- 400ml distilled white vinegar
- 200ml cider vinegar
- 35g brown sugar
- 10g salt
- 5g cayenne pepper
- Olive oil

METHOD

- 1 Combine the spices and salt, then liberally rub on the brisket.
- 2 Over a hot coal barbecue, put the soaked smoking chips over the coals and barbecue the meat on all sides. Place the lid on the barbecue. Turn brisket every 2–3 mins until completely charred.
- 3 Place brisket in a deep roasting tray with a wire rack in the bottom. Fill with one inch of meat stock. Cover tightly with foil and roast in the oven at 120°C for a minimum of 8 hours.
- 4 Remove the brisket and check for tenderness. Once cooked, allow to rest in the tray. (When the brisket is cooked you should be able to stick the back of a spoon into it with minimum resistance. If you need to force it into the meat you will need to return it to the oven and cook for longer.)

For the vinegar sauce:

- 1 Sweat the diced onions and the capsicum in olive oil in a heavy-based pot.
- 2 Add the spices and brown sugar and start to dissolve. Add all liquid ingredients and bring to the boil, reduce the heat to simmer and cook until the capsicums and onions are very soft.
- 3 Using a blender, liquidise until a smooth sauce is achieved. The sauce should be balanced between hot and sour. If required, add either more sugar or vinegar to balance out.
- 4 At The Newmarket, we serve this dish with a fresh crisp and crunchy slaw of Napa cabbage, snow peas, white onion and fragrant herbs. Slices of dill pickle are a must-have accompaniment to this dish. ★

Hey, true brew

A two-week shelf life makes Carlton Draught unpasteurised tank beer as fresh as it can get

WHEN THE BREWING PROCESS for beer is finished, the brewer taste-tests his creation to ensure it's ready for packaging. It's at that point that the beer is at its freshest, and it's how brewers would ideally like their beer to be tasted by consumers, says Jaideep Chandrasekharan, chief brewer at Carlton & United Breweries.

Unfortunately, the process of supplying beer to consumers in bottles and cans, and to venues in kegs, requires a process called pasteurisation, where the beer is quickly heated, then cooled, in order to remove any impurities and bacteria, and to prevent

the beer from going sour. This process slightly affects the taste of the beer.

A new process is now allowing beer drinkers to get closer to that moment of ultimate freshness, with tankers delivering unpasteurised Carlton Draught directly to venues. Those bars and pubs can then serve the fresh draught beer to consumers from large copper tanks on their premises.

"It's the same Carlton Draught," says Jaideep, "but the essential difference is in the freshness of the beer. There are businesses in the Czech Republic who distribute beer this way, one of which is Pilsner

Urquell. I suppose that's where we got our inspiration.

"This is another way for us to emphasise the fact that consumers can get brewery-fresh beers," he says. "The brewers normally taste the beers in the morning at the brewery, and release that beer for packaging."

It's at this stage that the beer would normally be pasteurised and packaged. The tank beer, however, skips this step.

"Once the brewers have released the beer, it is filled into a tanker and shipped to the pub," says Jaideep.

The fact that it is unpasteurised presents logistical problems in the ➤➤

DIRECT ACTION

The beer flows straight from tank to glass at Naked in the Sky, where it's a big seller



distribution of the beer, which must be consumed within 14 days. Delivery to Melbourne venues is easy enough; the difficulties arise when delivery is to cities further away.

Cleanliness and hygiene become more pressing concerns with unpasteurised beer, from the brewery right to the consumer's glass.

"There's a quality-assurance process that we have with our brewery-fresh team," says Jaideep.

So what are the benefits of dispensing beer in this way? Does it taste different?

"I think a couple of things are different with the tank beer - the vibrancy of the aroma gets retained, and the beer has a smoother taste on the palate," says the brewer.

With the growth of craft beer and the expansion of beer-drinkers' tastes, perhaps this new offering is not surprising. Says Jaideep, "We've found that consumers' repertoire and choice is increasing, and certainly this is a way of providing consumers with something different."

The feedback from venues is glowing: "I think the idea that the beer is unpasteurised and has come straight from the the brewery has a big appeal," says Max Fink, owner of Naked in the Sky. "It's one of the strongest selling beers we have."

The Terminus Hotel in the Melbourne suburb of Abbotsford started stocking the beer in August.

"The (CUB) brewery is 400m down the road from us," says Scott Elvery, general manager of Sand Hill Road, which owns the Terminus. "The volumes we go through are great. We have capacity for 3,000 litres on site,

and we're filling those about 1.5 times per week. At the Terminus, it's the leading seller, and lots of customers comment on the freshness."

While CUB has focused on Melbourne for the initial distribution of the beer, it's keen to look further afield, with more venues stocking the tanks in Sydney and Adelaide. ★ **Carlton Draught tank beer is stocked in venues around Melbourne, Sydney and Adelaide with more venues to come; visit cub.com.au**

Great fermentations

New technology in brewing has seen a rise in homebrew kits. They don't come cheap, but they are pretty darn cool

Cheap and beerful

Simply throw all your ingredients into **The Beer Machine**, stick it in the fridge a few days later and after a week or so, you have your own brews. The unit requires you buy its beer mixers, which skips steps in the traditional brewing process such as boiling. They are sold

in packs with carbon-dioxide canisters and de-foaming discs.

The Beer Machine brews in smaller amounts and lacks the impressive appearance of the WilliamsWarn (next page), but it is a whole lot cheaper, too. It can be bought online or from Big W. \$129; beermachine.com.au



Heads up

The Grainfather makes up to 25 litres of beer in a sleek metal unit that won't look too bad in the poolroom. Simply add the grain, then begin the brewing process by extracting sugars, before transferring to a fermenter without the risk of oxidation.

It can also make both high- and low-alcohol beers. With a small adjustment, you can use the unit to create your own whisky from grain, leaving your home-brewing rivals gobsmacked with jealousy. \$995; barleyman.com.au



Dam good

Anyone who brags their brewing relies on guesswork and "gut instinct" is one to avoid running into empty-handed at a party. Brewing is about the right temperature and the right time. Hence the thermometer on the **SS Technologies Brew Kettle**, which

makes it easy to get consistent batches from your homebrew operation.

The kettle is also the first on the market with an integrated trub dam, which the makers assure us provides clearer beer. The unit has silicon handles for easier use and a three-piece ball valve.

HOMEBREW HINTS

The four words that strike fear into barbecue-goers all over the country: “Try my home brew!”

However, not all home brew need have that sour, oxidised taste that has you claiming designated-driver status before a second plastic bottle is offered your way. To avoid the social faux pas that is crummy home brew, an expert offers his tips.

“Cleanliness is next to holiness when it comes to brewing,” says Patrick McInerney, who has graduated from home brewing to co-owning his own Sydney craft-beer brand, Willie the Boatman.

“A lot of home brewers don’t clean fermenters properly. Also, when home brewing, people really need to watch the temperature that they are pitching the yeast. If the temperature is above 24 degrees when you pitch the yeast, it gets stressed and can produce some pretty funky odours. I call it “the taste of Ivan”. Ivan is a mate who thankfully has given up on home brewing. All his beers turned out funky.”

Home brewing generally involves moving liquid between containers, increasing the chance of oxidation. The **WilliamsWarn Personal Brewery** accommodates the entire brewing process, right down to pouring. That way there is no risk of oxidation, or loss of quality due to storage at non-refrigerated temperatures.

The unit is so easy to use, you could operate it *after* drinking. All materials, such as yeast, water and grain, are placed inside. Temperature is maintained via digital controls and you pour from a tap on the top.

Novices can use the company’s ingredient kits, meaning results are guaranteed from all but the most clueless users. As people build confidence, they can experiment with different styles and ingredients.

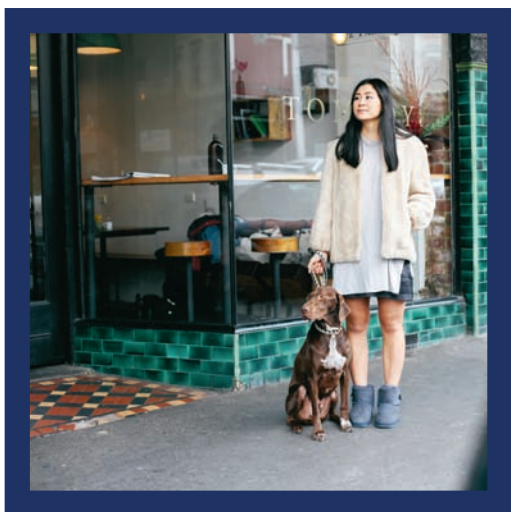

Sole mates

Two Aussie shoe designers, each one half of a creative couple, tell how they stay one step ahead of the business

Lauren Trickey started &Attorney with her husband Mitch

I studied a Bachelor of Design (Fashion) at RMIT, but it wasn't until I landed a role in New York that I worked in footwear. There, I learnt about fit, leathers and materials, trims, sizing, and style.

Mitch and I arrived home from New York in 2011. We were happy to be back near the beach, and wanted to work from our home in Barwon Heads, Victoria, so we started a shoe company. The first pair of shoes we made was a closed-toe mule on a chunky wooden platform. They were an amazing navy-blue suede that we still wish we had more of!

We started out modestly, selling our shoes in a few stores that were willing to give us a go. Most boutiques make sure their racks are full of clothes, but if budgets are tight accessories are the first things to go. After a season or so, many stockists sold out of our classic boots before winter had even hit.

I start designing by scouring leather wholesalers. In Australia, you

are restricted by what is available in terms of leather textures and colours. Particular combinations can inspire me – sometimes it's matte leathers next to metallics, or nautical fixings like cotton rope.

I take cuttings and lay them out on my kitchen bench, then play with combinations. Once I have a palette of leathers I'm happy with, I start sketching. I think about what lasts [models of the foot] we have available – these dictate the shape. Occasionally I want a new last created, so we work with a Melbourne last-maker, Bruce

– the last in Australia!

We work with a factory in Sydney to bring our designs to life – it's run by a family business of three brothers who immigrated to Sydney from Armenia over 20 years ago. We develop the designs together, and after a few trips back and forth a range of samples are ready for our buyers.

Petr and I began collaborating in 1994. I was a shoemaker and wanted to sculpt my own heel and toe shapes, and Petr's natural abilities and training as a sculptor meant that I turned to him for advice. He found the process inspiring and started making his own designs. We both bring a different eye to the design process, which makes our shoes unique.

We moved into a space in Fitzroy in 1994, and for a long time that's where all our shoes were made. We

eventually opened a shop in Gertrude Street with some clothing designers, but we felt that we were being lost in that environment and decided to reinvent our existing studio space as a salon. It's a beautiful building, where customers can see shoes being made (we have a small sideline making



orthopaedic shoes, some of which are custom-made at the studio).

We used to make all the shoes ourselves, but as we became busier we employed old-school shoemakers to look after production. Since they retired, and after a lot of trial and tribulation, we moved our factory to Bali, where we employ four incredible shoemakers who make everything by hand. I'll bring them small tools from Australia that would simplify some processes, but they refuse to use them! Working from Bali allows us to continue small production runs and maintain exclusivity.

Craft is apparent in all our designs. We distress some leathers for a unique finish and order custom leather colours. Our customers enjoy wearing colour on their feet – you can get black shoes everywhere! *

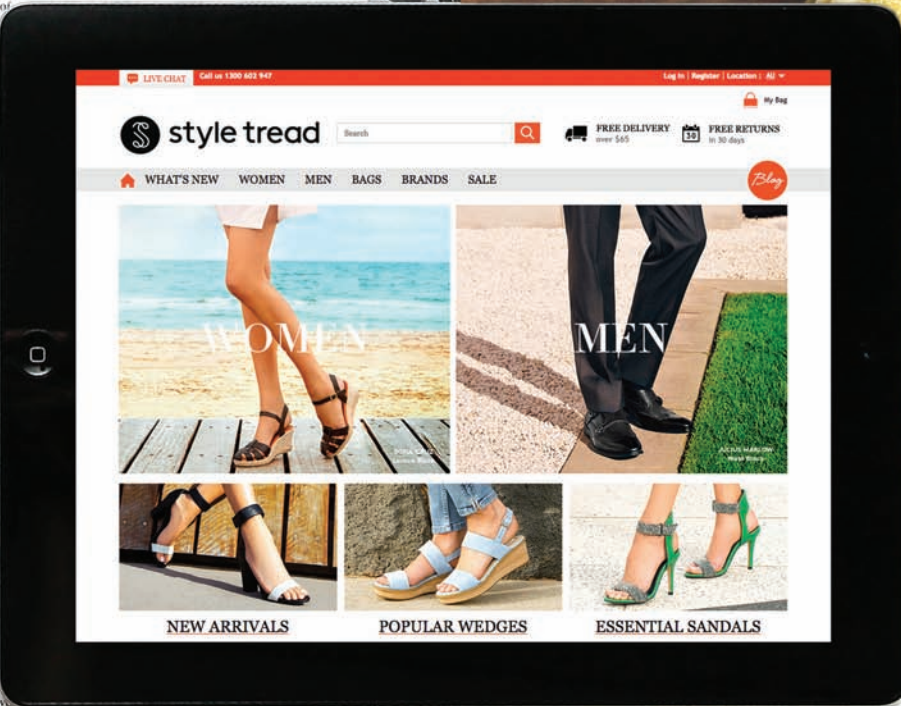

IT'S BEEN QUITE A WHILE now since Christmas festivities ended, but my eyes are still looking the worse for wear. WEAR DARK GLASSES: I've been relying on Marilyn Monroe's faithful beauty trick to get by: dark sunnies and a slash of red lipstick. Not only do sunglasses hide baggy eyelids, they also protect eyes from harmful UV rays that can cause blurriness and fine lines.

BROWS AROUND: One clever trick to disguising dull eyes is a well-shaped brow. Says brow expert Amy Jean Linnehan from Amy Jean Eye Couture: "Well-shaped brows give an instant 'lift' to your eye. Use concealer to knock out redness and create a base for your eye make-up."

COLOUR CORRECTION: For the best and brightest make-up look, avoid pink-based eye make-up, as well as anything blue, frosty or glittery, as it will draw attention to tired eyes. Opt for matte shades of brown and taupe, which help eyes look wide-awake. A little cream-coloured liner on inner eyelids helps counteract redness, too.

EYE-CARE KIT: Always carry eye drops in your handbag, and keep an eye pack in the fridge to apply to party-weary eyes in the morning. *

Saving face

Too late to prevent your skin from suffering summer scorching? Then try these helpful tricks



IT HAPPENS TO ME every year. Sun + summer = ravaged skin. After emerging from office hibernation at the end of December, I subject my body to daily blasts of sun followed by evening drinks – countless parties and idle time spent on the beach with a cold one in my hand. By now, the outdoor life should have me looking tanned and rugged. In reality, my skin is more sunburnt and haggard.

So, what to do? If it's actual sunburn you're dealing with, in the first one to three days it's all about pain relief, says dermatology

specialist professor Rod Sinclair from the University of Melbourne. Cool showers, local anaesthetic sprays (such as Solarcaine), painkillers (Panadol or aspirin) and ceiling fans are good. Putting your regular moisturiser in the fridge can help, too.

Moisturisers generally work for six to eight hours, adding hydration, removing skin scale, restoring the function of the damaged skin barrier and promoting healing if you suffer from eczema or psoriasis.

"If the skin is dry there will be temporary

hydration," says Rod. "If oily it may exacerbate oiliness and cause acne."

If you use a face wash it's important to make sure it's mild, says Nathan Jancauskas from online skincare company Men's Biz.

"You definitely shouldn't be using anything that strips the skin and makes it feel dry or tight," he says, adding that it's worth following up with a moisturiser specifically designed for dry skin.

Oh, and don't forget to drink plenty of water. It's great for the complexion – not to mention your liver. ★

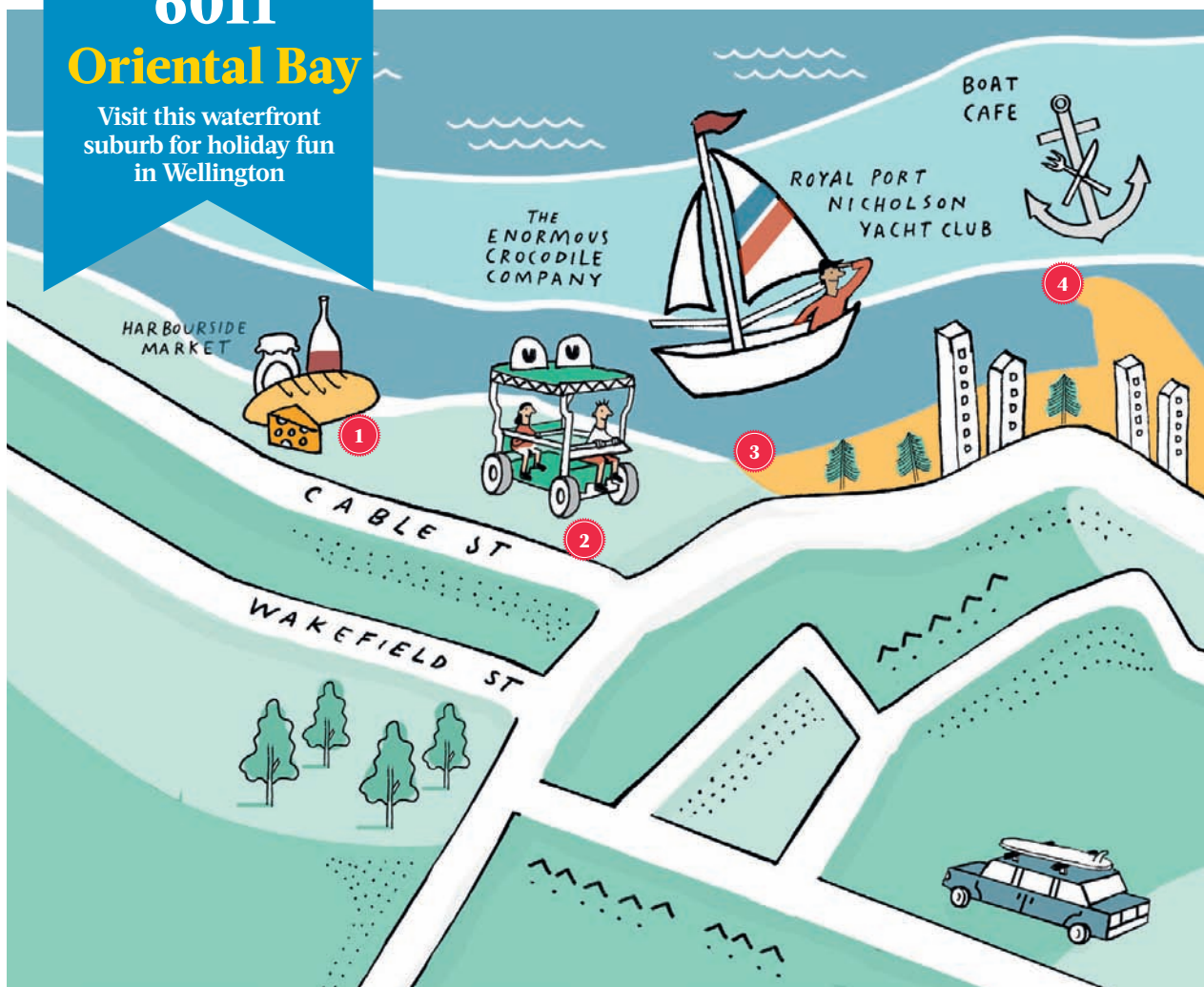

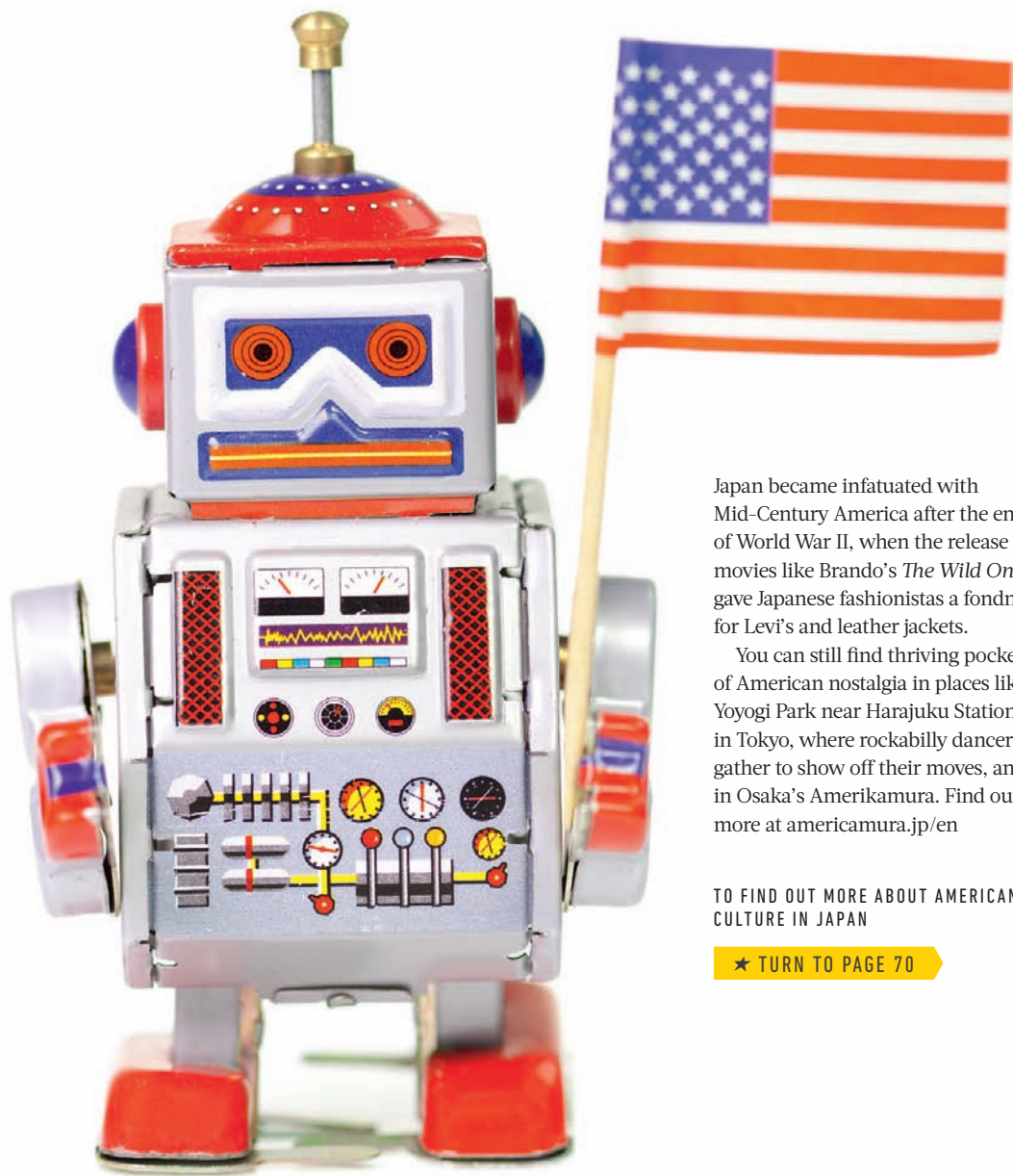

“MY FIRST MEMORY OF SURFING IS BEING DOWN AT FIRST POINT, NOOSA

with my brothers, Seb and Bart, and my parents, Mick and Nola,” says Julian Wilson, the 26-year-old professional surfer from Coolumb, on Queensland's Sunshine Coast. “I was playing in the sand, playing in the water and getting pushed into waves by my mum while the rest of the crew were surfing out the back.”

This innocuous first surfing memory was a turning point for Julian. He has since made a career as a surfer on the international pro circuit.

“My brothers are three and five years older than me, and had been surfing since they could walk,” says Julian. “It was a natural path for me to do the same.”

While he was just a grommet back then, he's now been on the World Championship Tour (WCT) for four

years, with his best result being ranked sixth in 2013.

While many expected the 26-year-old to continue his rise last year, 2014 started off being not the best for Julian, with his WCT ranking slipping to 21 towards the end of the year. This put his place on tour at risk, as only the top 22 automatically qualify for the next year's WCT. To ensure his place, he put in extra effort in Qualification Series events (a separate ranking, the top 10 of which enter the WCT). With great successes at the O'Neill SP Prime in Brazil and the Reef Hawaiian Pro, placing fifth and second respectively, Julian locked in a third-place ranking in the Qualification Series, and thus his place on 2015's WCT.

“I don't place more importance necessarily on one event over another,”

he says, “but towards the back end of last year I needed to go and get a few results on the Qualification Series to back myself up, and did that in Brazil and Hawaii.”

The real turnaround for Julian came with his performance at the Hawaiian Pipe Masters in December of last year. Julian not only won that event (against 2014 World Champion Gabriel Medina in the final) but also took out the Triple Crown of Surfing title, meaning that he came out on top overall at the three Hawaiian WCT events – the Pipe Masters, the Reef Hawaiian Pro, and the World Cup of Surfing. The performance boosted Julian’s WCT ranking to 14.

“Winning the Pipe Masters is the biggest competitive accomplishment of my career without a doubt,” says Julian. “Adding the Triple Crown on top of that shows me I’m capable of reaching the levels of success I’ve always wanted.”

With his standing locked in, Julian will aim to continue his good results into this year’s events, starting off with the Australian Open of Surfing in Manly, Sydney, held this month. At each competition on the circuit he’ll be looking to replicate his success at the Pipe Masters.

“I’m trying to win every event I compete in,” he says, but the bold statement is offset with the realisation that he’s doing what he loves: “I have an amazing opportunity to do what I do and compete on the World Tour. It’s important for me to enjoy that while chasing success.”

The high-stakes WCT really takes off with the Quiksilver Pro Gold Coast event, which also starts this month. It’s as close as the international tour gets to Julian’s hometown of Coolum Beach, and he’s one to watch at the event. Spectators are sure to notice him because of the trademark ➤➤



bright pink board shorts he wears and the matching board he rides.

"I am an ambassador for the National Breast Cancer Foundation," he says. "I was inspired by my friend Matthew Hayden, who started using a pink cricket-bat grip to raise awareness for breast cancer. I saw an opportunity for me to do something similar. I'm trying to reach a bit of a younger audience in an effort to educate women and girls of all ages about the importance of checking yourself and early detection."

It's a cause that's particularly important for Julian - his mother Nola is a two-time breast-cancer survivor.

"I couldn't be more proud of the way she beat it both times. I'm so thankful that she did," he says. And not only are the board and shorts in an eye-catching shade of pink, but Nola herself creates their designs.

"Mum is very talented," says Julian. "She has a unique style that I like. I just gave her a surfboard to use as her canvas and she did some great stuff, so I love to give her that opportunity whenever I can. My sponsors such as Hurley also liked her style and it's become a bit of a theme for me. It's great to have Mum's input on design and have a tie between my boards and board shorts from time to time."

For now, Julian is preparing for his first 2015 appearances on the waves for the Qualification Series and the WCT, and getting some rest hanging ten at the break he enjoys surfing most in his spare time: "Home! Doesn't matter what the conditions are like - it's actually not very good most of the time - but I love being able to surf at home with family and friends." ★

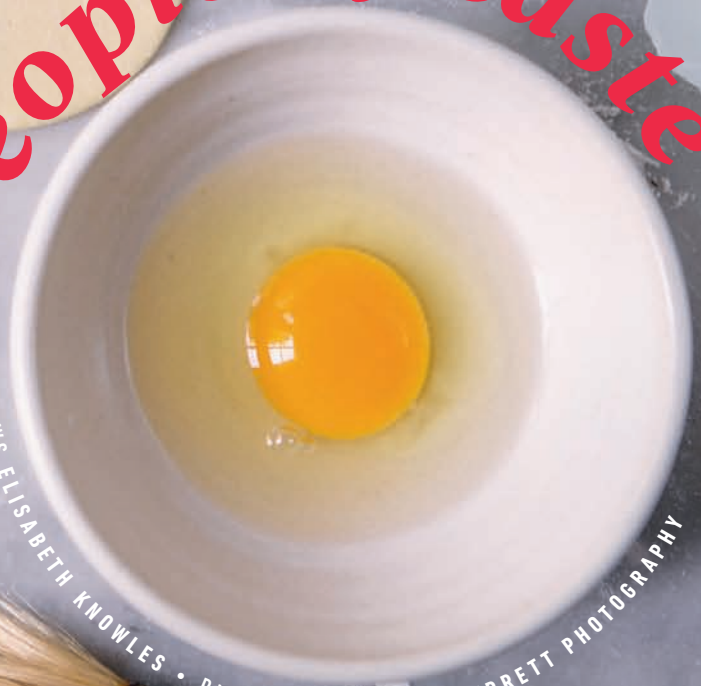
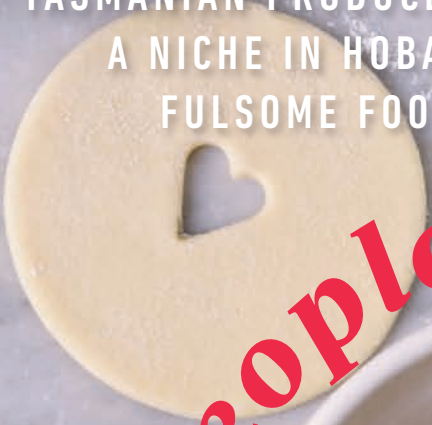

Curating food

Hobart foodie Jo Cook does for local produce what MONA does for art – makes it truly special

While many Hobart visitors are attracted to the Museum of Old and New Art for its avant-garde exhibits, come summer travellers and locals alike descend on the gallery lawns to sample some of the region’s finest food at its Sunday market, MoMa.

“When the market started in 2012 it featured produce, but we found that people didn’t come to MONA to buy groceries,” says Jo Cook, local-food curator at MoMa and the Dark Mofu Winter Feast. “Food buyers already have Salamanca Markets on Saturdays and the Hobart farmers markets on Sundays – their shopping is covered. We decided to focus on food you can’t get anywhere else.”

This year, MoMa stalls will still feature great local produce, as made into yummy treats by some of the best local foodies. But remember: this is MONA’s market, and as MONA likes to do things a bit differently, don’t expect kebab stalls, hot-dog stands and gözleme grills. Like everything else at MONA, from its galleries to its music festivals, MoMa is curated. This year’s theme: Eat Your Friends.

MoMa creative director, and MONA founder David Walsh’s wife, Kirsha Kaechele, says of the theme: “Eat Your Friends is about enjoying a loving relationship with the plants and animals we eat – really understanding where they come from.”

Jo says Kirsha’s themes are mindful of the politics of food: “They challenge people to really think about food production. She also throws in a playful spin. A previous theme was Eat the Problem, where we encouraged

stallholders to design their menus around invasive species like wakame and the long-spined sea urchin, which are introduced pests that destroy the habitat of our native species.”

But back to this year’s “friends”: “Gerard from Nicholls Rivulet Organic Farm is literally eating his companion cattle herd after years of care and kindness,” says Jo. “He turns the beef into pies with handmade pastry, and the most tender and delicious meat you can imagine.”

“After spending time in China and Mexico, Adam from Rough Rice is infatuated with chillies, and is now living among jars of dried chillies in his kitchen and pots of chillies outside.

“Thao from Chikko Cafe interpreted the theme as ‘Eat! My friend!’ She’ll cook *goi cuon ca*, a dish of barbecued whole fish in rice-paper rolls from her hometown in Vietnam, which she equates to sharing with friends. ➤➤➤

TELL US A BIT ABOUT YOURSELF

Having been born in Paris, I've had a lifelong passion for flavoursome, high-quality food. My family migrated to Australia when I was four. Life outside the house was Australian but at home our lifestyle remained very French. My mother made sure there was always good food on the table.

I haven't always been a farmer. I worked as a landscape gardener in Sydney until the recession in the 1980s. When people could no longer afford to employ gardeners I had to re-invent myself. During the 1990s, I

found my way into the kitchens of some of Sydney's top chefs where I learnt a lot about preparing food.

My partner Deb and I eventually opened our own restaurant on the NSW Central Coast. The concept was to serve delicious, honest food inspired by French country cooking. Not a wise move during the peak of nouvelle cuisine! With that also came the frustration of not being able to source quality produce for the restaurant. So we decided to go into farming.

Before moving to Tasmania in 2003 we owned an organic olive farm near Mudgee. I then explored a number of organic-farming ventures before settling on growing beef as the most sustainable venture for the terroir. We run a herd of Murray Grey, Angus and crossbreed cattle.

For me, the most important factor in the quality of the meat is how animals are raised. Being an organic farmer, I do not use any artificial fertilisers on my land. I place as much importance on feeding the life that is in the soil as on feeding my cattle.

Raising cattle is now complemented by growing a unique variety of ruby-red rhubarb and a small range of vegetables for use in our kitchen. In early 2014 we decided to call on my partner Deb's training in professional baking and pastry making to bake and sell pies, vegetarian Tasmosas (Tasmanian samosas) and sweet tarts.

WHY SET UP AT MOMA? This is the first time we've participated in a market outside our local community in the Huon Valley. We love our local markets, where we know most of our customers by name and where we can have a good old yarn across the pie warmer.

But, as they say, magic happens outside your comfort zone. What we love about MoMa is that the organisers get people to think about the food they eat.



WHAT'S ONE MUST-TRY PIE FOR VISITORS TO MOMA? At the first MoMa on 17 January we launched a new pie variety that we developed in partnership with the guys from MONA's Moo Brew beer company. It's a dark-ale-infused pie with a chunky beef filling.

TELL US A BIT ABOUT YOUR

BUSINESS My sister Erin and I make sourdough doughnuts with Middle-Eastern-inspired fillings. We use seasonal ingredients from Tassie because it's important to us to support friends and small producers and use what's around us. Local and seasonal produce tastes better, too.

We've had lemon curd and strawberry-and-lime jam doughnuts on the menu for a few months now, made from fruit Erin pilfered from her neighbours' trees. They don't use them so they'd go to waste otherwise. We also use berries from Green Elephant, our friend Ryan's business. He has a property on the Elephant Pass in St Marys.

Tasman Sea Salt is another ingredient. I was intrigued by the idea of harvesting salt on the east coast so we tried it and it's a great product. We've stumbled upon such a supportive community in Hobart – especially at Farm Gate Market. We have a stall there every Sunday and each week we meet different small producers, and buy our vegies, honey, fruit – anything we can use for doughnut inspiration.

WHY USE SOURDOUGH? Sourdough gives the doughnut a slightly tart flavour, and an earthy quality. Neither my sister nor myself are bakers, pastry chefs or even chefs – we just like eating sourdough and baking! Before we launched our business there were months of recipe testing, reading and chatting to bakers until we were happy.

Our sourdough “starter” or “mother” is like my child. We nicknamed ours “Muddy”. He needs feeding twice a day and has to be kept

at a certain temperature. I wrap his tub in a blanket my grandma knitted – it's hilarious, but he's very precious. Starters last forever. I've visited bakeries in Paris who used the same starter for decades – we've only had ours for one year so I feel a definite pressure to keep him happy and alive! We got the starter from Graham at The Companion Bakery in Oatlands. Sadly, the bakery is no longer open... Graham has a wealth of knowledge, so I feel lucky to be using a starter from him.

WHAT'S ONE MUST-TRY DOUGHNUT FOR VISITORS TO MOMA? Our new flavour – vanilla, rose and pomegranate – or go for the classic dark choc and salty pistachio.

TELL US ABOUT YOUR BUSINESS

“Rough rice” is what the Chinese call brown rice. It is delicious, healthy and sustainable. This stall is going to be all about rice and my other love, chillies, with influences from around the world like China, Mexico and Japan – countries that I’ve travelled or lived in. The chilli component will come in various guises – sambals, moles and fermented pastes.

WHY SET UP AT MOMA? This is my first market stall anywhere. I’ve been working with food in one form or another for 15 years but never in a market. I’m excited about cooking at MoMa – it’s certainly not your typical farmers market! As MONA does with everything, they’ve added quirk, class and, well... fun... I also like that this year it will be on Sunday afternoons – perfect for capping off the weekend in the sun with a beanbag on the

grass, good live music, a couple of drinks and delicious food.

I’ve been planning the stall for some time. So far I’ve been enjoying experimenting at home making things like *doubanjiang* (Szechuan fermented broad beans and chilli), black vinegar sambal and preserved black bean, shaoxing and ginger paste.

The main dish served will be brown rice bowls – biodynamic Australian brown rice seasoned with a cascabel chilli oil, various toasted seeds, kale and spring onion and served in a “coconut bowl” and eaten with chopsticks. A couple of dishes that might make an appearance are wild rabbit mole rojo with crispy kale, sesame and coriander, or fried duck egg with kimchi, ginger sambal, nori, sesame cucumber and laksa leaf mayonnaise.

TELL US ABOUT YOUR CHILLIES I have 14 varieties growing at home, including Trinidad scorpions, padrons, cayenne, habanero, Scotch bonnet, Chinese seven pods, aji amarillo and Bulgarian carrot. Probably my most-used

chilli would be the guajillo – one of 20-odd dried varieties found in Mexico. It is great in moles and salsas or for flavouring oils. It's not particularly hot but has an excellent depth of flavour.

HAS A CHILLI EVER "BEATEN" YOU?

Last year I went and worked in restaurant called Hartwood in Tulum, Mexico, in the Yucatan Peninsula – home to the habanero. The local Mayans eat them like apples. Now, I have a pretty reasonable heat threshold but on my first "family dinner" at the restaurant, sitting with a bunch teenage Mexicans who were eating them like chips... one bite had me sweating profusely and reaching for the coconut milk – much to everyone's amusement!

WHAT'S ONE MUST-TRY DISH YOU'LL BE SERVING AT MOMA? At the launch of MONA FOMA music festival in

January, cutlery and crockery were not permitted, to minimise wastage for the 5,000+ expected visitors. For this market I'll continue that practice and make *sang choy bao* (filled lettuce cups) with wallaby fried rice, carrot pickle and doubanjiang, or a vegetarian option with brown rice

with eggplant mole amarillo and coriander and pepita salsa.

WHERE ELSE CAN PEOPLE TRY YOUR FOOD? I'm one half of Tricycle Cafe in the Salamanca Arts Centre. I've been running this business for eight and a half years now. Many

of the combinations that I'll be serving under Rough Rice have been trialled and tested in the café.

**BRUCE MILNE TELLS WHY HE LOVES THE
SUBURB IN THE HEART OF OSAKA THAT'S
BESOTTED WITH AMERICAN CULTURE**



Though guidebooks state that Amemura (officially, Nishi-Shinsaibashi) was once an old warehouse area,

older locals laugh at this description. It is partly true, but what has been whitewashed out of official history is that it was also a notorious red-light district, full of gambling dens, brothels and yakuza (gangsters).

That started to change in the mid-1970s when a few young surfers, lured by the area's cheap rent, opened shops in Nishi-Shinsaibashi selling old Hawaiian shirts, sneakers and accessories. Before long, the range of shops and styles, most with an American theme, increased dramatically.

The Japanese media dubbed the area "Amerikamura" (America Village) which was quickly shortened to Amemura. Many of the buildings got into the US-loving action also, with giant American-styled artworks including King Kong, the Statue of Liberty and huge clowns. Even the street lampposts are sculpted to look like robots.

Amemura has changed considerably over the years. Worldwide designer-brand stores and department stores now occupy many sites



where small, unique shops once stood. But little gems still exist – they're just hidden in the basements and upper floors of buildings. Part of the fun of the area is venturing into the buildings, exploring and searching out the treasures that lie within.

You can find everything from 1940s zoot suits and 1950s jeans through to punk leathers and hip-hop hoodies, along with many other wild, Japanese subcultural fashions that defy categorisation.

I have spent times in Osaka without venturing far from this colourful, vibrant area. The hotels are cheap, the array of food available is staggering and there is always something fascinating happening on the street. Best of all, I keep discovering more surprises.

Central to Amemura is Sankaku Koen (Triangle Park). This small, popular meeting area is always overflowing with kids in all sorts of strange attire. It's a great place to start your Amemura adventure.

There are giant American-style artworks, including the Statue of Liberty and King Kong

Japanese youth fashions can often be very way out, and emanate from the street level up. Amemura, like Tokyo's Harajuku, is the place to see all the latest, developing trends. On weekends, especially, Osaka's youth dress up, meet up at Sankaku Koen and parade the streets. Photographers from Japanese fashion magazines comb the area to shoot the constantly evolving, grassroots styles.

Many stores have sprung up in nearby Minami-Horie. Here, small galleries, young-designer clothes shops and some of Osaka's newest (and trendiest) restaurants and bars are flourishing. Minami-Horie is easy to find – just head 100 metres west from Amemura, under the freeway, across busy Yotsubashi Street and you're there. Look for the well-signed Orange Street and explore.

Amemura has a second face at night-time. As the retail shops close, the crowds thin out a little and the restaurants, bars and clubs really start to come alive. It is after dark that you get to experience the sense of community that



exists here, as exhausted shopkeepers pull the shutters down and head to their fave local restaurant to eat, relax and share a beer. If you have experienced the quiet sophistication of Tokyo, you may get a shock at the loud, happy way Osakans unwind. Don't be surprised if the locals chat and laugh away with you, regardless of whether or not you understand a word. It's a great way to practise (or, at least, to hear) the casual, friendly Kansai-ben (Kansai dialect).

Apart from the restaurants, stalls selling *takoyaki* (battered and grilled octopus balls) and yakitori (chicken skewers) pop up around Amemura at night. If you're on the go, it's a quick, delicious and very cheap way to fill up.

Much later in the evening, Amemura's bars start to come to life. Like the unique stores, most of the best bars are not obvious if you're on street level. A bit of deep probing into the buildings can be richly rewarding. One famous building, Nippo Mitera Kaikan, was built in the early 1960s for seedier reasons but now houses over 40 tiny bars, each with its own distinct flavour. Wander around the hallways and squeeze into one that looks appealing. You won't be disappointed.

Time Bomb Records

Time Bomb is a world-famous record store (and label) selling new and used 7-inches, LPs and CDs. It specialises in all forms of rock'n'roll, from rockabilly through to punk and experimental. The owner, Kenji Kodama, travels constantly around the world looking for stock. Even if you don't have the money (or urge) to buy a rare Swedish Rolling Stones EP or South African Elvis 10-inch, it is fun to ➤➤



see what they look like. And there are plenty of bargain bins as well.

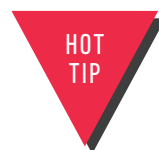

It's the height of summer in Australia and New Zealand – the beaches are rammed,

the barbie is perpetually sizzling and thoughts are more geared towards sand and surf than skiing and snow. Not for everyone, however. For the dedicated winter tribe, summer is merely the all-too-long off-season before chilly dreams become a powder-snow reality. The Queenstown and Wanaka ski fields are currently preparing for the 2015 ski season, and with new facilities on the go and improvements on the cards, it's looking to be another banner year for ripping up the NZ slopes. Here's what to expect:

→ THE REMARKABLES KICK OFF

The biggest changes in Queenstown are at The Remarkables. At the start of last season "The Remarks", as locals call them, opened the Curvey Basin chairlift, radically changing the ski field. This new chairlift increased the resort's lift capacity and added a number of new trails in the process. The virgin terrain was an instant hit with locals and visitors alike. They also did some serious work on the access road, sealing the bottom four kilometres, with another two kilometres of blacktop to be added before the 2015 season opens.

The Remarkables' increased lift capacity also meant a spike in popularity for this Queenstown ski field, and the knock-on effect was that its ageing day lodge passed its use-by date. Problem solved for this season: NZSki has spent the summer constructing a new 5000m² day lodge with a three-sided balcony for kicking back on. Built to a similar layout and aesthetic to the stunning day lodge at Coronet Peak, this contemporary build proves that The Remarkables have come of age.

→ CORONET PEAK'S CROWING GLORY

Speaking of Coronet Peak, the sister mountain to The Remarkables, that ski field is also planning a few changes for 2015. Last season saw a big increase – 35% – in night-skiing capacity. And with 200 snow guns at the ready, Australasia's most reliable snow is set to be back right on time for opening day in May.

Plus, this year, for the first time in nearly a decade, lift-serviced mountain biking made a comeback at The Peak. ➤➤➤

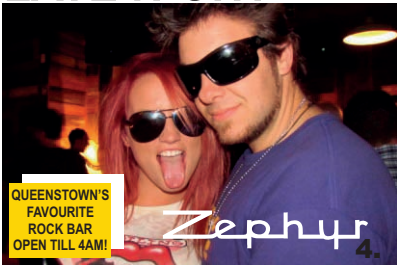

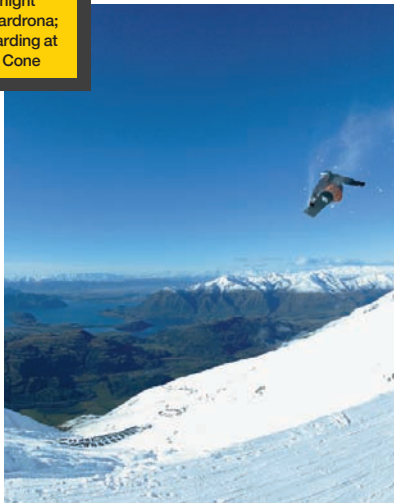

→ **TRAILBLAZING TREBLE CONE**

Over the hill near Wanaka, the iconic Treble Cone has some big changes this year, too. Intermediate skiers will relish the addition of new terrain. The ever-popular Saddle Basin area has long been the haunt of expert riders, but a new intermediate trail, Side Saddle, has opened up the area to a wider group of snow enthusiasts. In addition to the new trail, earthworks are under way to widen a few classic runs to make them a bit easier to negotiate and help get all skiers around the mountain.

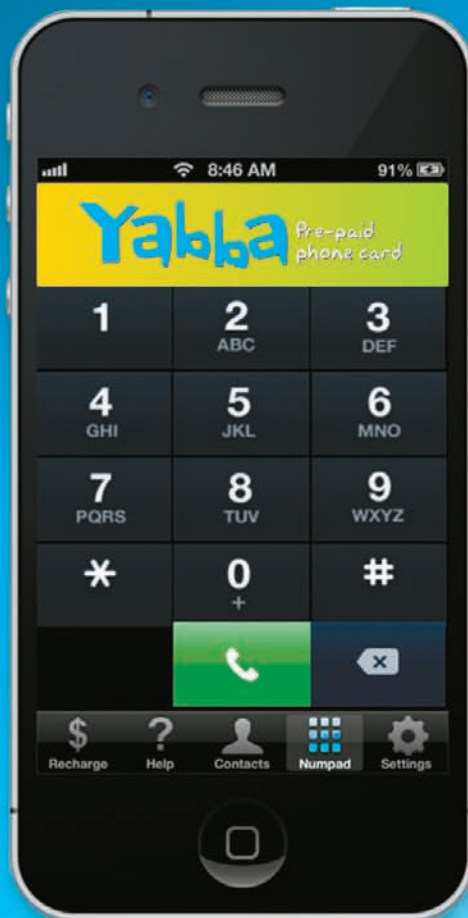
We all know heading up the mountain isn't just about the skiing and the snowboarding, and at TC they've added in a new mid-mountain alfresco café, the perfect place to take in the alpine view and grab a sneaky flat white. Located at the top of Home Basin, it's accessible to all levels of skiers, and to sightseers. With one of the best views anywhere, this will be the place to go for a deep breath, a selfie and a bite to eat off the grill.

→ **CARDRONA FOR KEEPS**

On top of The Crown Range, halfway between Queenstown and Wanaka, sits family favourite Cardrona Alpine Resort, or "Cardies", which has long been the choice for skiers and snowboarders looking for expansive beginner and intermediate terrain. Changes for 2015 all help to stake that claim and grow more fans, one perfectly groomed run at a time.

Four new snow groomers mean that the corduroy will be even more wall-to-wall and some minor summer earthworks have given the trails a tidy. The biggest expansion here is the season itself, after years of sustained stunning weather in September and October. Cardrona is expanding its season at both ends, opening a week earlier and closing a week later. And in keeping with the local trend, summer lift-serviced mountain biking is available at Cardrona too. It was a hit over the Christmas holiday period and is returning for a cheeky weekend from 17 to 19 April. ➤➤

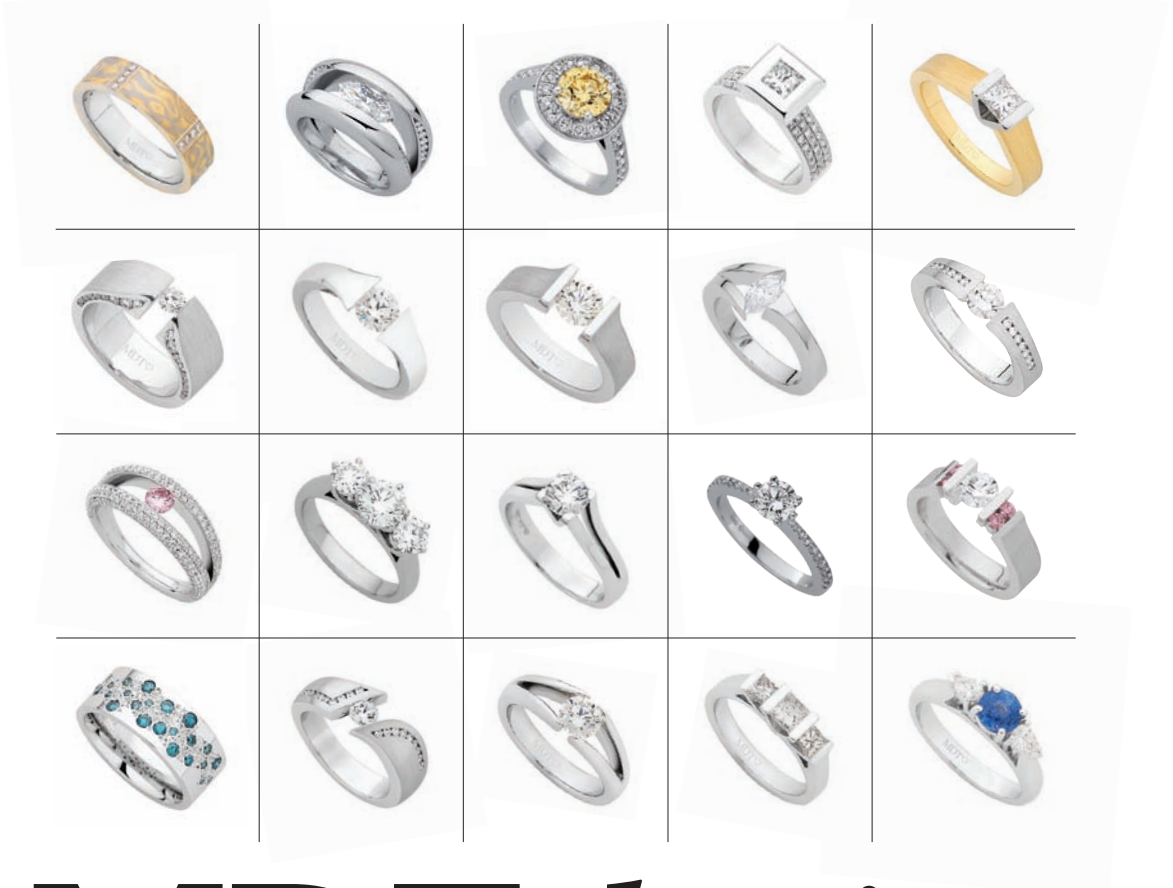
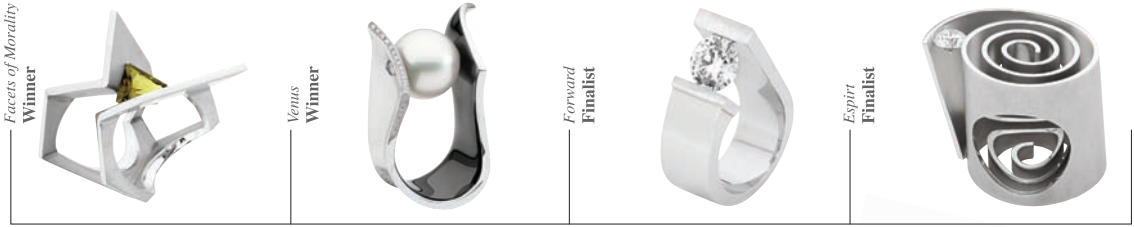

MY WEDDING: We got married at a private villa owned by the wedding company Faraway Weddings – Faraway Villa on Samui.

MY TIP: Have all guests stay in the same resort, and organise it yourself. With a lot of the stress of organising the wedding being taken away by a wedding planner, this will give you time to think about somewhere special for all your guests to stay together. It was important to us that our guests stay in the same place so they could get to know each other. We researched the perfect place based on budget, amenities and location, then organised a discounted rate for our guests based on the number of bookings.

A TRICK YOU MAY WANT TO STEAL: As Thailand is very hot and humid, the groom and groomsmen all got tailored outfits from Timmys Tailor in Chaweng, Koh Samui that consisted of linen trousers and white, untucked shirts. As the ceremony was on the beach, they also wore white thongs.

A MISTAKE TO LEARN FROM: We didn't video the day, which is now a big regret.

Krystal and Grant Irving married at Katathani Phuket Beach Resort

OUR STORY: Our family had never travelled internationally before, so we wanted to choose a destination we were familiar with so we could guide and support them. As we'd been to Thailand a few times it was the perfect choice.

We chose this resort because Katathani is well-known for its weddings – the venue is stunning and I have to admit to being practical – they had a beautiful undercover option in case of rain (and rain it did!).

MY TIP: Learn to let go. I found it challenging because I'm a bit of a control freak. Planning a destination wedding requires an enormous amount of patience. I hired a local wedding planner, and while it did slow down the process (as you have someone in the middle managing everything), ultimately it helped as she was able to handle negotiations, make changes, and organise the small logistical items that take a lot of time like transport.

SPECIAL CONSIDERATIONS: I had a number of guests with serious food allergies. One of the

reasons we chose Katathani was because of its reputation for catering to dietary requirements, which they did very well. Instead of a wedding cake we decided to have a hilariously tacky champagne tower, which ended up being a total disaster. The champagne didn't cascade down the glasses; rather, it poured over the top layer of glasses straight onto the table! But it did give everyone a good laugh.

AN IDEA YOU MAY WANT TO BORROW FOR YOUR WEDDING: We chose to have a First Look Photo Shoot. This is where the bride and groom see each other for the first time, in private, an hour before the ceremony and it is captured on camera. It was so beautiful and intimate and helped us to relax before walking down the aisle. It was definitely my favourite part.

A MISTAKE TO LEARN FROM: Get legally married in your home country first. For sentimental reasons we wanted our marriage to be legally recognised in Thailand, but in hindsight it was too complicated to be worthwhile. We had to go to Bangkok for several days, which involved visiting the Australian embassy to have paperwork validated, translating the paperwork into Thai, then it went to the Thai government for validation, and then we went to a local office in Phuket to sign it all and make it official. It was only after all the documentation was finally translated into English weeks later that we realised they'd gotten our dates of birth wrong and it was therefore invalid, so it all had to be sent back after the wedding to be amended!

WHY MARRY IN PALM COVE? We wanted a beach destination and loved the privacy Palm Cove offered. It has a small-town vibe, and reminded us of Bali – our favourite holiday destination. The ceremony and reception was held at Peppers Beach Club and Spa. We got engaged at another Peppers property, so it was a sentimental choice.

ABOUT THE WEDDING: We invited 120 guests, so to have 85 attend was amazing. Most came from Sydney, but we had guests from Hobart and New York, too. Because Palm Cove is close to many tourist spots, people made it their holiday for the year.

DID YOU USE A WEDDING PLANNER? Peppers have a wedding coordinator who was there from the first meeting until after the wedding – Lizzie Randall. She was outstanding. I had phone meetings with Lizzie every fortnight, then weekly meetings closer to the day. I found it to be pretty stress free.

Lizzie provided a list of local suppliers to help us work out decorations, cakes and photography. Food was catered by Peppers – we decided on a buffet to keep the reception relaxed. It was a really good icebreaker for guests who didn't know a lot of people, as they'd chat while serving themselves food.

SOMETHING SPECIAL: Having two brides was unique enough, but we were lucky to have two separate aisles for us to walk down, so there was no compromising.

MY TIP: With a destination wedding, you need to consider the weather as it will determine when you can have it. With North Queensland, we needed to take into account cyclone season as well as stingers, so that narrowed down our options to a few months.

WHY MARRY IN HAWAII? It was a second wedding for both of us and we were blending four children as a family after several years together, so we thought it would be a lovely idea to make it a "family holiday". We knew that if we were to marry in our hometown, Sydney, it would have been a much larger wedding than we wanted. It worked beautifully because we spent several days in the lead-up to the wedding at Waikiki, visiting the North Shore and attending a luau – it created festive feel. It wasn't a formal wedding in a banquet room, just around 30 friends with an afternoon ceremony followed by a gorgeous five-course dinner.

HOW DID YOU CHOOSE THE VENUE? We were married at the Four Seasons Resort in Hualalai. I came across an image on the Four Seasons website of a gorgeous semi-alfresco restaurant area. The way the tables were presented in that photo were so appealing, and it could accommodate the amount of guests we were hoping for.

A MISTAKE TO LEARN FROM: We FedExed all six outfits for the wedding party (my dress, my husband's suit, children's clothes, etc) over to the hotel, which was quite costly. We didn't want to haul them around Waikiki. It would have been cheaper to pay an airfare for a guest to carry them over for us.

AN IDEA YOU MAY WANT TO BORROW FOR YOUR WEDDING: We made the children part of the vows – made promises to them and presented them with a little gift. We wanted to make it feel like it was their wedding, too. The only downside was when we suggested going back to Hawaii for future anniversaries and they said they would have to come, too!

WHY MARRY IN HAWAII? We had our ceremony in Hawaii as it was one of the few places in the world where we felt truly comfortable as a gay couple. We'd visited Honolulu many times and had always felt accepted by the Hawaiian people and thought it was the perfect place to exchange rings – tie the knot, so to speak. This was before gay marriage was legalised, so the best we could do was have a commitment ceremony.

ABOUT THE CEREMONY: We arranged for a local Hawaiian marriage celebrant who was also gay. Both she and her partner came along to the ceremony and celebration afterwards. We were married on the beach at sunset, in a secluded area where we could feel comfortable. We had a Hawaiian guitarist and hula dancer during the ceremony, Hawaiian blessings, exchanging of leis and conch shells. The setting and surroundings were perfect.

We went to the Paradise Cove luau afterwards so we could all have a few drinks.



It has a special area set aside for weddings that was once for Hawaiian royalty, so you certainly do feel special on your special day. Their banquet includes Hawaiian cocktails such as mai tais, blue Hawaiians and pina colodas. The service and show is fantastic.

HOW DID YOU ORGANISE IT? I organised all of it online and made a couple of phone calls to the celebrant beforehand. We organised beautiful Hawaiian leis for all of the guests once we arrived.

Twenty-six guests came from Australia and they all stayed at the Princess Kaiulani hotel. We had a group rate, which was very reasonable. We find that Sheraton hotels always look after their guests well.

MY TIP FOR A DESTINATION WEDDING: Be aware of the local culture and respectful of their ways. Don't be too ocker, especially when overseas. Also, your wedding is a celebration of who you are, and to do that you need to be in a place where you want to be, not where you think your guests want to be.

DID YOU HONEYMOON AFTERWARDS? We had a few days in Waikiki with our family and friends and once they had all left, Anthony and I went island-hopping for one week. We love all of the Hawaiian islands but there is so much to offer on Oahu. There are plenty of secluded beaches, great restaurants and lots of shopping.

ABOUT OUR WEDDING: We wanted a destination wedding because my family is in Malaysia and the Netherlands and my husband’s family is in the UK. Asia seemed a great choice – midway between Australia and Europe. We rented a traditional beachfront Balinese villa to hold the ceremony and the reception in. My husband wanted a sunset wedding on the beach.

HOW WE PLANNED IT: I made a trip to Bali six months prior to the wedding to scout for venues and met up with wedding planners to decide which would suit us best. It gave a good understanding of the costs involved.

SOMETHING SPECIAL: The villa had just been renovated. We stayed in a beautiful “hut” with its own plunge pool.

FOOD TIP: I didn’t want formal dining, and wanted to continue a Balinese theme, so we arranged live cooking stations and kept it buffet style. There were stalls of seafood, meats, satay,

salads, stir-fry noodles and rice to cater to carnivores and vegetarians.

GUEST COMFORT: There were several things to consider with an outdoor wedding, such as the heat. Misty fans were hired to keep our guests cool, and we organised a “thong basket” of various sizes for the ladies. It was perfect for when they wanted to take a break from their heels, and also for ladies who didn’t realise grass is not a stiletto heel’s friend.

AN IDEA YOU MAY WANT TO BORROW FOR YOUR WEDDING:

My best friend is a Justice of the Peace and she somehow managed to get all the guys to sign a petition prior to the wedding day, telling them it was something for the groom. And at the end of her wedding speech, she asked for those who’d signed the petition to stand up and place their hand on their hearts, state their name and make a pledge to support our marriage. In the event that they would be called upon to mediate between my husband and I, they must remember that I am always right. Ha! She then handed me the document she had written up along with all the signatures. That was gold!

WHY BALI? We'd been looking at venues for a few months and wanted something out of the ordinary. I fell in love with Bali even though I had never been, and my husband was easily convinced given the surfing. We were extremely lucky to have 60 of our closest friends and family join us in Bali. Everyone jumped at the chance to take extra time off work to holiday together afterwards. We gave everyone plenty of notice, which I think is crucial for anyone planning a destination wedding.

MY ADVICE TO BALI BRIDES: Be spontaneous! A bit of an ad-lib moment came the afternoon before the wedding when we were enjoying a couple of champagnes at sunset. We saw some people on horseback riding on the beach past our villa. We thought it would be great to get horses for the wedding, and so my mum and bridesmaids went down to the guide and booked them in! We did have a bit of an

incident midway through. My husband and I were getting photos on the horses when my beautiful long veil flowed over the horse's tail and the horse had an accident on it! We cleaned it as best we could, but I did feel a bit sorry for my wedding party, who had to endure the lingering smell throughout the photos. But the show had to go on and it's these little moments that made the occasion so much more memorable.

Be adaptable! When you have a destination wedding, things may go a little off plan, but smile and enjoy those moments as they often tend to be the best part. Bali is renowned for an afternoon shower and didn't disappoint; this was a blessing in disguise as we were told rain on your wedding day is a sign of good luck. It rained for about 20 minutes so we served cocktails and canapés for the guests on the undercover terrace and then the staff dried everything off and we went back to the planned schedule of announcing the bridal party, cutting cakes, speeches, first dances and then lots more dancing into the night with a live band, which of course turned into bridesmaids' karaoke.

ABOUT OUR WEDDING: We chose Hacienda Villas because they have gorgeous event spaces and individual villas so guests have privacy. The accommodation takes up to just 28 guests, so you feel like you have the place to yourself, although they can cater for up to 100 guests at the wedding itself. As they were able to do the catering in-house, we saved money and the hassle of liaising with external caterers. We wanted minimum fuss and maximum enjoyment.

HOW WE PLANNED IT: Our first stop for inspiration was the blog baliweddingblog.com – it’s packed with advice for weddings on different budgets and has a comprehensive list of venues and organisers. It’s how we found our venue. The GM at Hacienda Villas was our main point of contact for everything – she was our planner, and she did a terrific job.

BUT IS IT LEGAL? Before you start planning the wedding, I’d recommend checking out the legalities of getting married overseas. Although many hotels and wedding organisers are keen to offer a lavish ceremony, as a foreigner your wedding might not then be legally recognised in your own country. There’s often a lot of

bureaucracy (and cost) involved with registering it overseas. You can always do what we did and marry in a registry office in your home country, then have the party and a ceremony abroad.

HOW NOT TO GET RIPPED OFF: As far as payment goes, we were fortunate in that Hacienda had a PayPal account. Friends who also got married in Bali spent a lot of money making bank transfers to local Indonesian banks – it simply didn’t turn up in the right account. Ensure any supplier can accept legal payment from overseas via PayPal or Western Union.

SOMETHING YOU MAY NOT EXPECT: Typical wedding flowers such as roses and lilies have to be imported, so they are expensive. Local flowers are fresher, cheaper and more in keeping with the setting. It’s a similar story with food and wine... we chose an Indonesian menu and limited wine as it’s expensive in Bali – well, good wine is expensive. Instead we had free-flow cocktails, which was surprisingly more affordable.

WED THIS WAY: Six Tips For A Perfect Destination Wedding

Sarah Harris is the publisher of *Bride* magazine. She married Jesse Szulik at the Banyan Tree in Bali. Here, she shares her destination-wedding advice

1 PUT YOUR GUESTS FIRST: I'm English and my hubby is Australian. We chose Bali because it was a cheaper option for guests in terms of flights, accommodation and spending money. Plus, compared to Thailand, the weather is a bit better (less ouchie hot for the oldies).

2 PLAN AROUND YOUR OWN NEEDS NEXT: We got married at the Banyan Tree because it's not a resort I've seen loads of weddings at, so we didn't feel like just one couple of many. I was worried about this as working on *Bride* magazine means I see the same wedding styles over and over. The food is incredible, too, which was very important as we're foodies, and the resort itself is absolutely stunning!

3 RELAX! Don't get too bogged down in formalities in a tropical setting; it just doesn't suit. The boys wore short-sleeved shirts, suit shorts and a vest with thongs instead of a full

suit. My dress was certainly not puffy – no way was I going to wear a puffy dress! The bridesmaids were in comfy, flowing silk dresses to take the heat into account. Similarly, hair and makeup was done in such a way as to make sure being a bit hot and sweaty wouldn't ruin the look.

4 DON'T FRET THE GUEST LIST: Quite a few people couldn't make it due to money, or if they had kids – though we did invite them too. Note to all brides: don't take this personally! People have lots of things going on and while your wedding is huge for you, it might not be feasible to attend for others. That doesn't mean they don't love you!

5 DON'T DISAPPEAR AFTER THE VOWS: One of the nicest things about a destination wedding is that the people there really want to be there – no freeloaders! I loved having a wedding that lasted a week – every day little groups did things together. All of our 30 guests made friends with each other, which really creates a beautiful connection for the future.

6 DON'T DIY! Get a wedding planner, no question about it. It's just not worth the hassle.

Safety, security & comfort

Jetstar is a wholly owned subsidiary of Qantas Airways Limited

★ Qantas group security

During check-in and boarding, you may have noticed security measures such as:

- Random explosive-trace detection of passengers and their carry-on luggage.
 - Laptops and aerosols being subjected to more enhanced inspection at airport screening points.
 - Increased vigilance at passenger screening points and increased guarding of our aircraft and terminals.
- Further measures apply to flights to the United States and Manila:
- Additional carry-on baggage searches just prior to boarding.
 - Random baggage searches at check-in and boarding.
 - Passengers selected at random for pat-down inspections, including the removal and checking of shoes.

★ Carry-on baggage

Liquids, aerosols or gels in your carry-on baggage must be 100 millilitres/grams or less and must be sealed in a transparent, independently resealable, one-litre plastic bag. You are only allowed one plastic bag. You may still carry on board prescription medicines. Baby products and non-prescription medicines that you need for the flight are also allowed. Proof of need may be required. Please note: the above-mentioned restrictions do not apply to checked-in baggage.

★ Safety first

Safety belts must be fastened during take-off, landing and when you are seated in case your aircraft encounters

turbulence. Luggage must be stowed in the overhead locker or under the seat in front of you. The back of your seat must be upright, and the tray table fastened when the aircraft is taking off and landing. Please remain seated after landing until you are invited to leave the aircraft. Sleeping on the aircraft floor is not permitted. Please read the safety instruction card in your seat pocket, noting emergency exits and location of life jackets. Please watch the safety demonstration prior to take-off. In an emergency, the crew will give specific instructions on what to do.

★ Smoking

Government regulations prohibit smoking on all flights operated by Australian-registered aircraft. There are smoke detectors in all toilets and penalties for regulation breaches.

★ The importance of blood circulation and muscle relaxation during flights

If you have concerns about your health and flying, Jetstar recommends you seek medical advice before flying. Compression stockings can assist in preventing swelling of the ankles and feet, and they may improve the blood return to the body from the lower legs. These stockings can be purchased from medical- and surgical-supply companies, and need to be individually fitted to your leg measurements to be effective. During your flight, move your legs and feet for three or four minutes per hour while seated, and move about the cabin occasionally.

★ Dangerous goods

Nail polish and nail-polish remover must never be used while on board an aircraft. The strong fumes can be carried through the air conditioning system, and affect other passengers and crew.

★ Listen to the flight attendants' safety briefing

Many passengers have seen safety demonstrations on numerous occasions. Taking the time to watch the safety demonstration every time that you travel will refresh and reinforce important safety information, so that in an emergency the information will be easily recalled.

★ Intoxication and disorderly behaviour

The cabin atmosphere is pressurised to about 8,000ft above sea level, so any alcohol you consume will have a greater effect on you than normal. It is against Civil Aviation Regulations to enter an aircraft while in a state of intoxication, or to behave in an offensive and disorderly manner while in an aircraft.

★ Jetstar Security Policy

Jetstar has a strict policy on denying boarding to any passengers who are inappropriate in flight or while on the ground in comments or behaviour. Jetstar does not accept any inappropriate comments as "jokes". All matters deemed inappropriate will be referred to the relevant authorities for prosecution. Jetstar will seek to recover all costs incurred as a result of inflight incidents from those parties involved.
