## Jetstar's on-time performance - November 2019

In November 2019, our New Zealand domestic network delivered 85% OTP on **Jet routes** and 89% OTP on **Regional routes** (results are for departures within 15 mins of schedule).

#### **NEW** +7kg carry-on = 14kg allowance

From 20 November 2019, customers who wish to take a little extra carry-on can purchase an additional +7kg carry-on which allows for a total combined carry-on weight of 14kg – size & piece limits also apply\*.

Attractive to customers wanting to accommodate heavier, more valuable items (laptop, camera, etc), take an overnight bag on-board, or for those travelling with infants.

This will replace the current +3kg carry-on option. Customers who have already purchased +3kg for travel on or after 20 November 2019 will have the +3kg allowance honoured.

Starter, Plus and Max fare customers can purchase the additional +7kg, or customers can choose to purchase a Flex fare which allows for a total combined 14kg carry-on weight.

- \* Size & piece limits apply maximum 2 items 1x main item weighing no more than 10kg, must fit in the overhead locker and not exceed 56cm (H) x 36cm (W) x 23cm (D). 1x small item must fit under seat in front, includes items such as a handbag or thin laptop bag.
- \* Excess carry-on baggage fees will apply to items exceeding 14kg allowance. Bag will be checked in.
- \* From 14Nov19, +7kg carry-on and Starter Flex not available on Trans-Tasman, New Zealand Regional or SHI (AKL-RAR, SYD-NAN, DRW/CNS/PER/ADL-DPS), and MEL-DPS from 14Nov19 to 28Jan20.

# 7kg carry-on for Starter, Plus and Max fares



Jetstar's standard carry-on allowance for Starter, Plus & Max fares is 7kg total weight – size & piece limits also apply\* - maximum 2 items.

Our airport teams keep a close check on carry-on weight to ensure customers are <u>complying with the 7kg standard allowance</u>. These checks can include <u>weighing all combined carry-on items</u>, including laptop bags, wheeled bags and handbags, at either the check-in counter or at the boarding gate.

Please remind your clients before booking flights to understand these requirements and ensure they have the correct carry-on weight – it is much cheaper to book the correct weight beforehand than be <a href="mailto:charged">charged</a> for non-compliant carry-on at the gate or at check-in on the day of travel.

- \* Main item: must fit in the overhead locker and not exceed 56cm (H) x 36cm (W) x 23cm (D)
- \* Small item: includes items such as a handbag or thin laptop bag; must fit under seat

#### **NOTE:** Flex bundle

From 14 November 2019, our Starter Flex bundle will no longer be available for purchase on the following routes (there are no changes to any other routes):

- Jetstar Airways (JQ) Domestic New Zealand Regional services
- Jetstar Airways (JQ) Trans Tasman, AKL-RAR, SYD-NAN, DRW/CNS/PER/ADL-DPS
- Jetstar Airways (JQ) MEL-DPS will not offer Flex for sale from 14Nov19 until 28Jan20
- Jetstar Pacific (BL) all Flights

On routes where the Flex bundle remains, particularly New Zealand Domestic A320 flights, the carry-on baggage allowance for all <u>new</u> bookings will increase from 10kg to 14kg total combined weight, all Starter Flex bookings made prior to 20Nov19 will retain 10kg.

Passengers who have purchased a Flex bundle on any of the above routes, on or after the 14 November 2019, will be provided a Starter Max bundle which includes additional products to the Flex and similar flexibility (10kg carry-on allowance will be honoured plus a 30kg checked bag).

#### Flex fares for business...and now with increased carry-on allowance

For only \$29 extra on a New Zealand domestic A320 flight, Flex saves you time and money, and provides comfort and convenience when flying on our Jetstar service in New Zealand.



- NEW 14kg\* carry-on allowance (max 2 items one main item up to 10kg & one small item to go under seat in front)
- Free upfront or standard seat selection (subject to availability)
- \$10 in-flight voucher (to be used in-flight only from our <u>Jetstar Menu</u>)
- Catch an earlier or later flight on the same day at no extra charge
- No fees for date, time or name changes subject to fare difference
- Cancel your flight and get a credit voucher valid for 36 months
- Qantas Frequent Flyer Points on all Jetstar NZ domestic flights
- For Starter Flex bookings from 20Nov19 carry-on baggage allowance will be 14kg total combined weight. Starter Flex bookings made prior to 20Nov19 will retain 10kg.

Our NEW food and drinks menu offers a wide range of hot and cold locally produced (AU/NZ) meals and snacks with a wide selection of vegetarian, vegan, gluten-free and gluten-friendly Passengers can also choose from a range of soft drinks, alcoholic drinks, kids packs plus a range of Jetstar gifts 'n' gadgets.

Food isn't included with our Starter fares, but you can purchase a meal, snack or beverage on selected flights. Whilst you can purchase on-board, we do however recommend you pre-purchase to get the meal of your choice, plus pre-purchase is cheaper!

Included in most of our fare bundles is food and drink, or Meal Deal where you can choose from the on-board menu.

On short A320 WLG-CHC sectors, passengers can purchase a snack and drink from our on-board menu via the call bell service, or pre-purchase a snack pack prior to flying. Jetstar accepts Visa, MasterCard, American Express, JCB, and Visa and Mastercard debit cards or a Qantas branded pre-paid travel card. No min spend/credit card fees.


### **Qantas Group net zero emissions commitment**
