#### **Jetstar NZ on-time performance**

In January 2021 we operated up to 94% of our pre-Covid schedule and I am pleased to share with you that our New Zealand domestic network delivered 95.0% on-time performance for our customers (results are for departures within 15mins of schedule).

#### Fly with confidence, Fly Well



Fly Well packs - wearing a face mask is compulsory for passengers on all flights between New Zealand and Australia and all domestic flights in New Zealand. Please take a complimentary Fly Well pack before you board, this pack contains a face mask and sanitising wipes for your flight.

You will need to wear a mask at the boarding gate and throughout your flight, unless you're under 12 years old or have a medical condition that exempts you. Your mask needs to cover your mouth and nose. You can use the mask from your Fly Well pack or bring your own.

### **IMPORTANT** Aviation Security Service policy change - batteries

From 1 January 2021, no loose or spare batteries will be allowed in passengers' checked luggage. This includes batteries in their original retail packaging.

There will also be a limit of 20 loose or spare batteries of any type allowed in carry-on luggage, unless an airline has approved the carriage of more batteries.



Each spare battery in your carry-on luggage <u>must</u> be individually protected by being in retail packaging, individual bag, a protective pouch, or with tape placed over exposed terminals.

This requirement is due to changes to the International Air Transport Association (IATA) Dangerous Goods Regulations. Please <u>click here</u> for more information.



Pre-Purchase now

Our new inflight <u>food and drinks</u> menu offers a range of hot and cold meals and snacks including vegetarian, vegan, gluten-free and low sugar options. Passengers can also choose from a range of hot drinks, soft drinks, or something from the bar.

Food isn't included with our Starter fares, but you can purchase a meal, snack or beverage on selected flights. Whilst you can purchase on board, we do however recommend you pre-purchase to get the meal of your choice, plus pre-purchase is cheaper!

Included in most of our fare bundles is food and drink, or Meal Deal where you can choose from the inflight menu.

As part of our <u>Fly Well</u> program, we have introduced a streamlined single-page laminated menu which is easy to wipe down and modified our card-handling procedures for our buy-on-board service

On short A320 WLG-CHC sectors, passengers can purchase a snack and drink from our on-board menu via the call bell service, or pre-purchase a snack pack prior to flying.
Jetstar accepts Visa, MasterCard, American Express, JCB, and Visa and Mastercard debit cards or a Qantas branded pre-paid travel card. No min spend/credit card fees. Jetstar does not currently have mobile device contactless payment available so please do ensure you have your physical card available on aboard.
